A traditional Tadelakt plaster finish.

ROCKCOTE Marrakesh is a skilled Artisan applied, fine grained lime plaster that can be used for both interior and exterior including areas of high humidity such as bathrooms and wet areas.

Our Marrakesh is based on natural 'Tadelakt' lime plaster which for centuries has been appreciated for its durability, warmth and pleasing appearance.

Application is not so much a process, rather an artisan plasterer skill that adapts with the changing climate to achieve a durable and beautiful feature to any room.

Historically, the wall finish of the palaces, hammams and bathrooms in Morocco.

Marrakesh is a tactile, gentle lime plaster with natural feel and look which has our Olive Soap solution applied during curing to aid in the carbonation process and water resistance.

Marrakesh is applied by skilled artisan plasterers and can be finished to a traditional flat, slightly distressed effect, or for a contemporary look can be polished and waxed to create a glass face marble plaster.

General

Can be applied over most stable building substrates following correct surface preparation. Marrakesh can be applied to prepared wet areas* such as showers and bathroom walls to provide a seamless wall surface.

As a natural lime plaster, Marrakesh will comply with the regulations surrounding the refurbishment and repair of heritage listed and architecturally sensitive buildings.

Traditional hand plastering application techniques are used to apply Marrakesh.

Generally applied in two coats after it begins to set it is floated, trowelled and compressed with an agate stone to achieve the desired finish.

* Not recommended for areas where water pools such as floors, bath tubs and hand basins. The underlying substrate must be tanked and waterproofed to meet or exceed the NZBC requirements.
